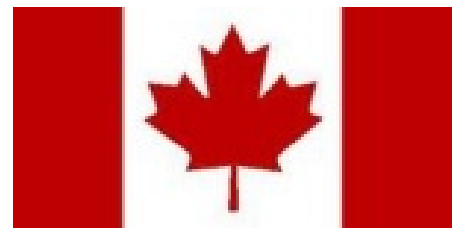
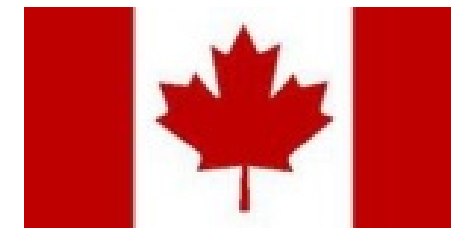


136th annual DDRA Canada Day Regatta at the Welland International Flatwater Center (WIFC)

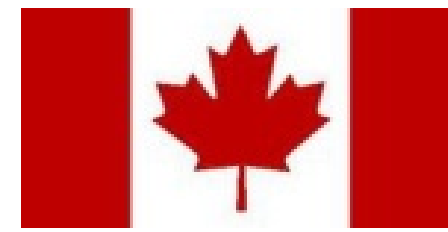
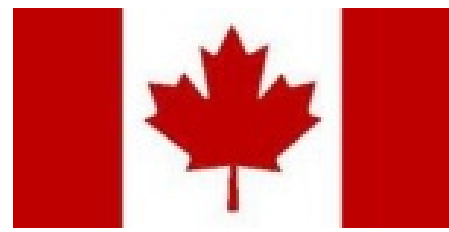
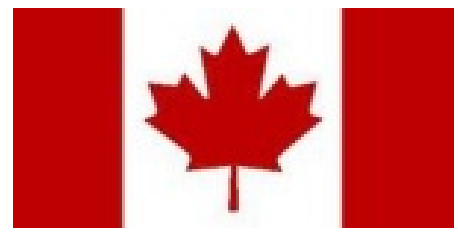
